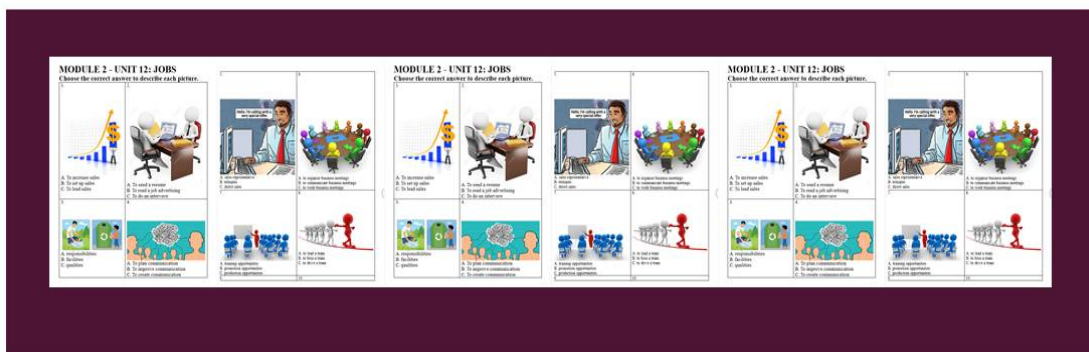

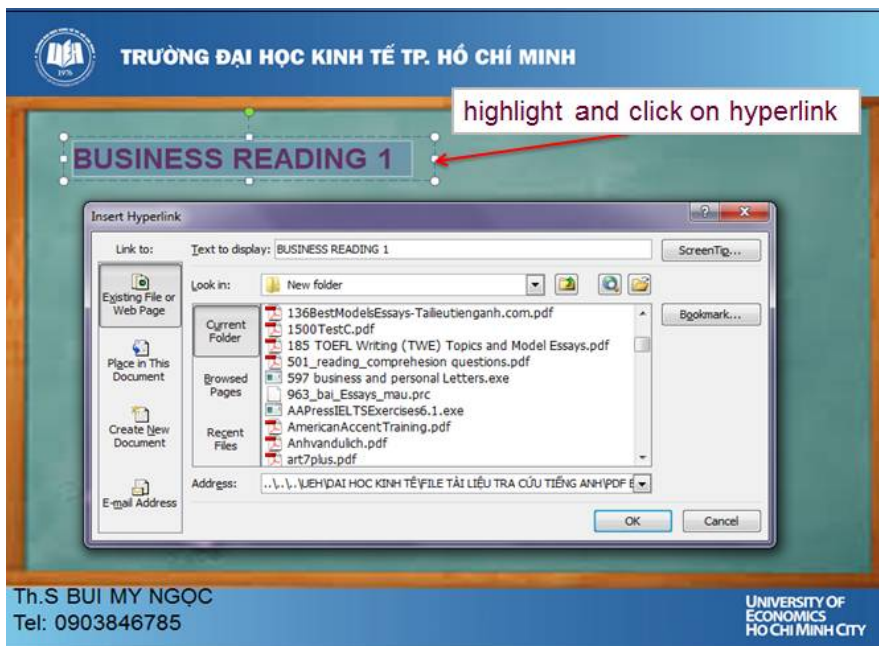

Choose Insert Menu → Hyperlink

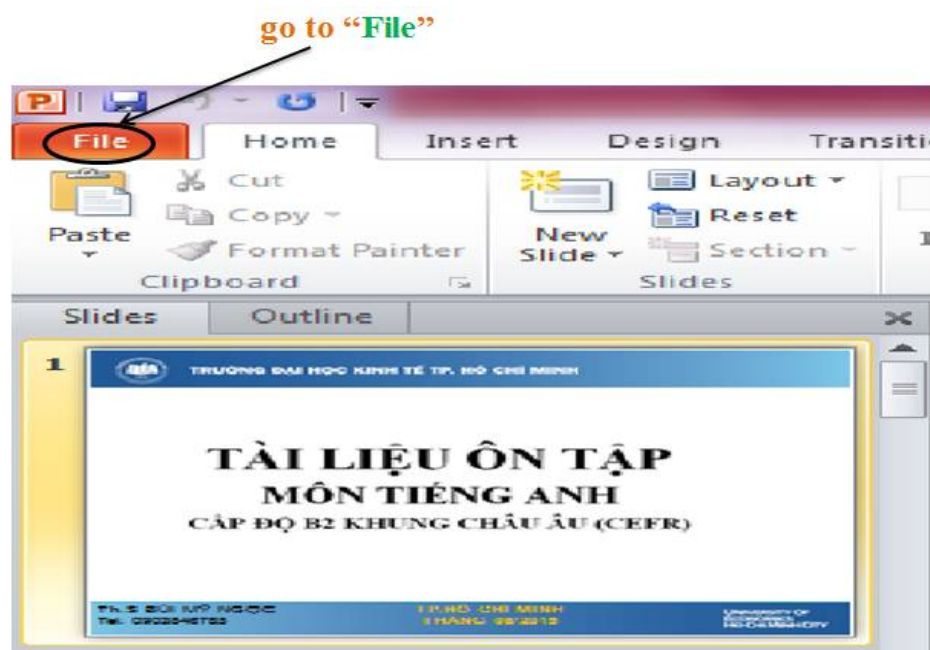
- On the left side of the Hyperlink popup, choose "Existing File or Web Page."

2.3.1 Choose "Existing File"

2.3.2 Choose the webpage:

- To link to a web site, type or paste the URL (starting with http://...) into the "Address" box.
- To link to a document, browse to the file you want to link up.

Note: for best results, only link to documents in the same folder as your PowerPoint deck. When you upload or send this PowerPoint to someone, you must also send the file you linked to.

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2.4 Content Sharing:

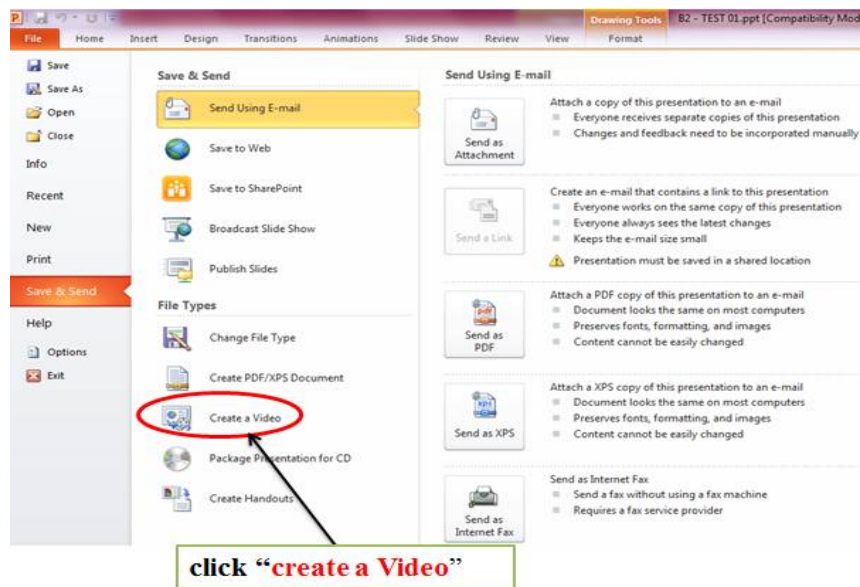

2.4.1 Go to "File,"

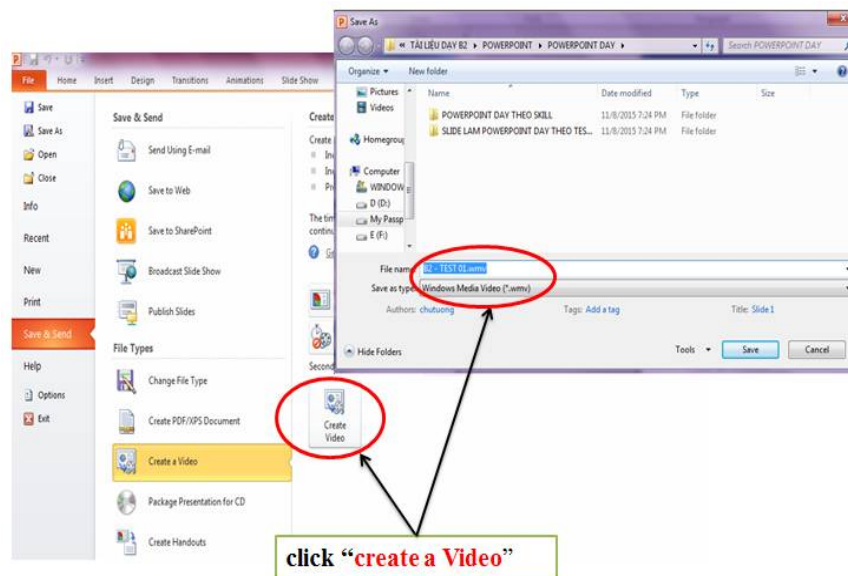
2.4.2 "Save and Send"

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3. TIPS TO MAKE YOUR POWERPOINT SLIDES MORE ATTRACTIVE

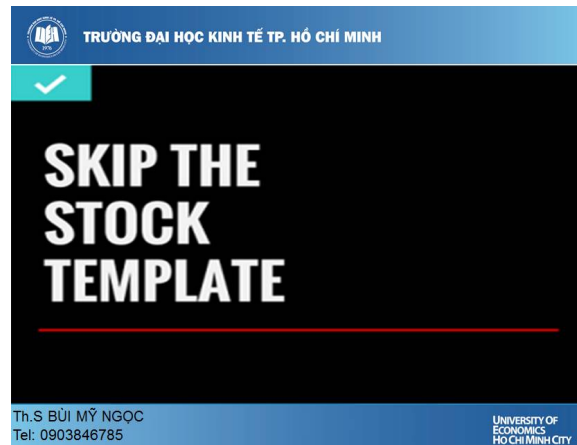
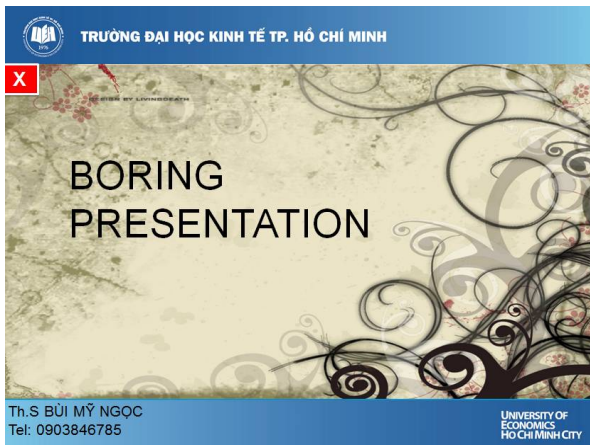
So far most of us have ever made PowerPoint presentation slides for ourselves. We may not take care of the following rules so that they can make our slides even better than expected.

In order to avoid it, we need to comply with the rules prior to our PowerPoint preparation as follows:

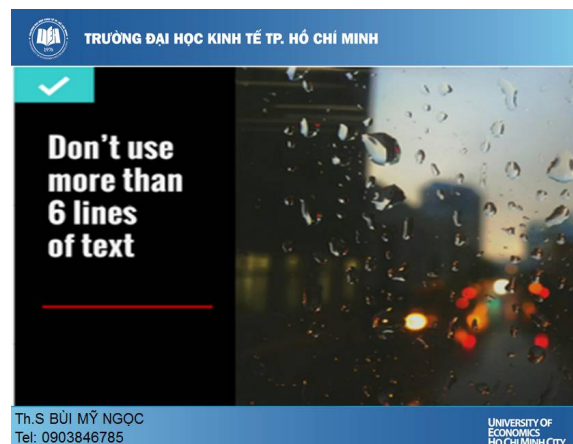
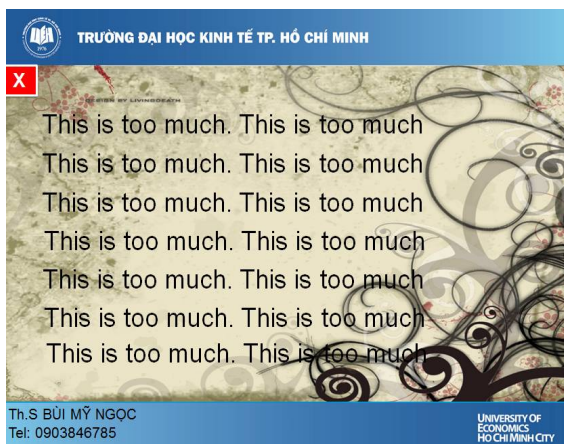
3.1 Skip the Stock Template

We should create cleaner presentations by starting with a clean presentation background and building from there.



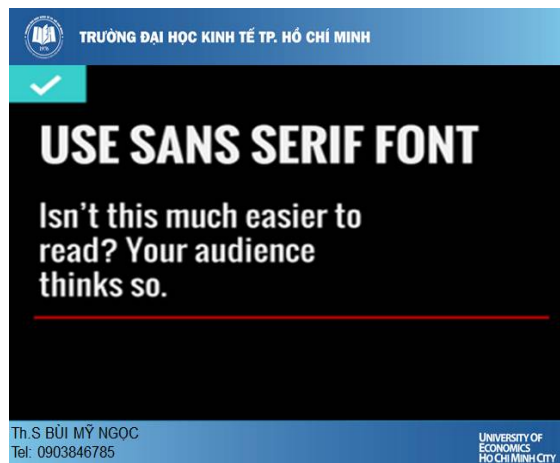
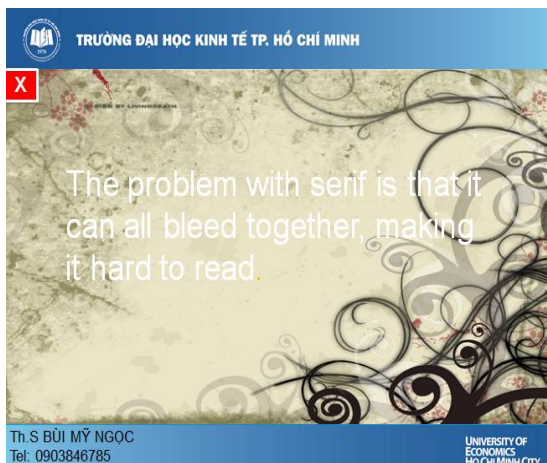
3.2 No more than 6 lines of text in one presentation slide

Packing too much information into a slide will completely undermine its purpose.

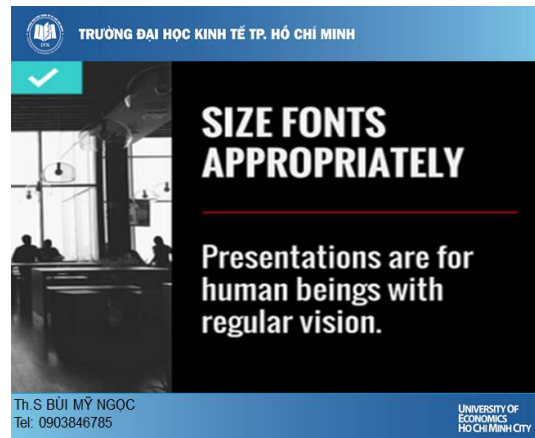
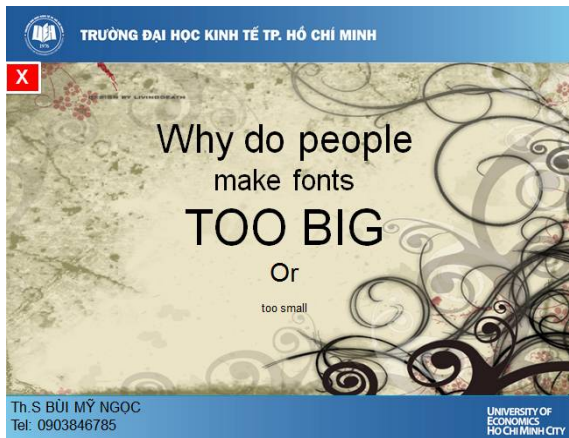


3.3 Use Sans Serif Fonts

In Microsoft office Word, there are many fonts we can use for your PowerPoint Presentation slides. However, it will be better if we use **Sans Serif Fonts** or **Helvetica** on a dark color background because this makes your text bold for readability.

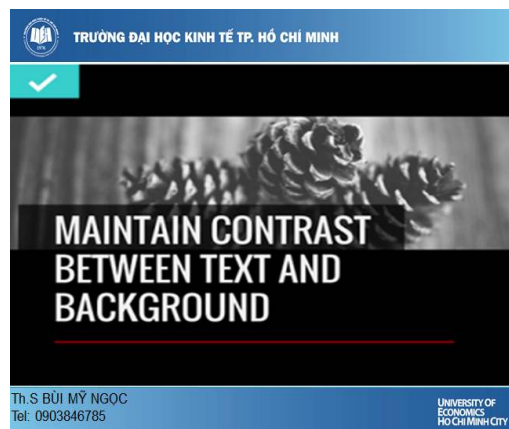
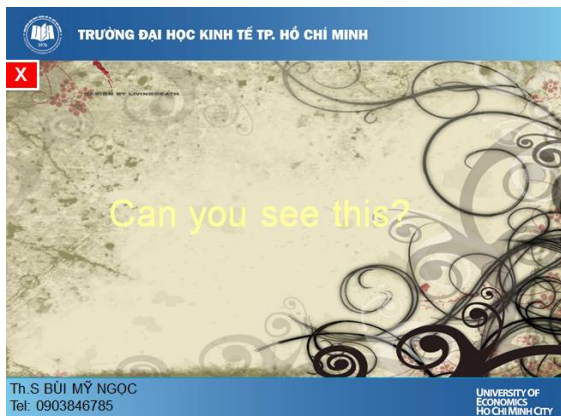


When we design your PowerPoint presentation slides, be sure that the text should be large enough to be read by all of our students, even the ones in the back of the room.



3.5 Balance a strong contrast between Text and background

In order for our message to pop, we need a high level of contrast between our text and the background. If your background image features a lot of variation, portions of your text may not be legible. In that case, a stylish bar of color behind the image can bring the legibility back while adding visual interest.



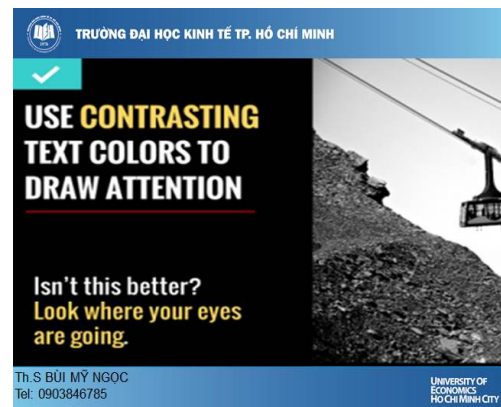
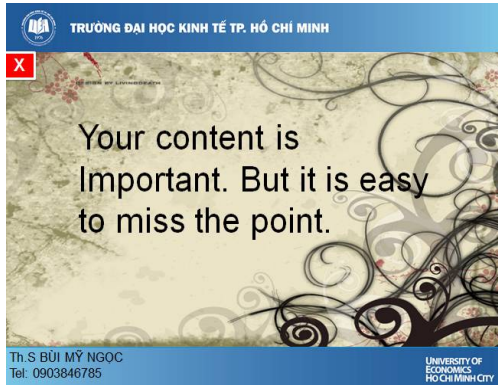
3.6. Use No More than 5 Colors

A harmonious palette can easily enhance the look of your entire presentation. No need for complex gradients or textures here; you can get excellent results with just the right colors



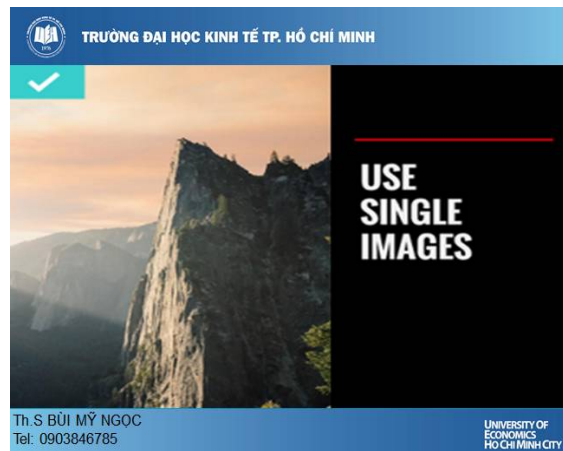
3.7 Use Contrasting Text Colors to Draw Attention

It's like bold and italic, but better. Use a single color in your selected palette to emphasize important points in your text. However, make sure not to overdo it.



3.8 Use Single Images

Images help make your presentation more visual, but don't get carried away with too many on one slide. It's a presentation, not a photo album. Limit your designs to a single image with simple or no text.



3.9 Use Visuals to Increase Emotional Appeal

Visuals are there to help support your message; they can enhance comprehension, retention and elicit an emotional response that increases impact. Use powerful visuals to get your point across.



3.10 Freeze the Transitions

There are plenty of clever transitions built into today's presentation software, but most quality presentations eschew any distracting transitions.

No matter what your presentation content, make sure you are always using design to your full advantages.

III. CONCLUSION:

We can come to conclusion that presenting a piece of information through PowerPoint slides will help the learners remember your message, so we should use recall aids. A recall aid is something that the audience can use to recall the points you have made after you are finished the presentation. There are many different forms of recall aids, including handouts, workbooks, cards, and PowerPoint. PowerPoint can be a recall aid because it can give visual reminders of the points we are making.

In fact, designing a nice PowerPoint presentation slides is to draw our learners' attention to the lecture and information we would like them to absorb.
